SWINE DIVISION

- Open to SD residents 21 and under as of Jan.1
- All exhibitors under 8 years old must have a personal supervisor in the show ring.
- Ownership as of June 1
- Hogs will be divided into four divisions

---Prospect Gilts (under 230) ---Market Gilts (230 and above)

---Prospect Barrows (under 230) ---Market Barrows (230 and above)

To qualify for Champion awards in the market division hogs must weigh 290 or under.

- All hogs will be shown by breeds

Each breed with at least five head in the division will have their own class; all others will be shown as Other Pure Breeds.

- Division Champions \$100, Reserves \$50

- Breed Champions \$50, Reserves \$25

• The show will be begin with Showmanship at 6:30 pm on Saturday and 8 am on Sunday.

- Entry Fee - \$20 per hog

- No pre-entry required. Fee paid at check -in.

• Weigh Ins: Scale will be open on Friday July 27 from noon to 7 p.m. and Saturday July 28 from 8 a.m – 3 a.m. Self declared weight cards. All cards must be turned in by 4 p.m. on Saturday July 28th.

- All hogs will be released after the show (non-terminal).

- All Purebred pigs must have registration papers at the show to qualify to be shown in purebred classes, if not they will be shown in the crossbred division.
