ALL LIVESTOCK MUST BE STALLED IN THE LIVESTOCK FACILITY

at the South Dakota State Fairgrounds - Huron, South Dakota

NO STALLING IN THE CAMPGROUNDS, TRAILERS OR NON-DESIGNATED AREAS!

STALLING + ARRIVAL TIMES

No reserving cattle stalls, or sheep / goat pens before Saturday, July 22nd!

Any signs, caution tape, duct tape etc. will be removed if put up before that date.

THIS ALLOWS THE STATE FAIR MAINTENANCE TEAM TO PROPERLY CLEAN THE FACILITY BEFORE OUR EVENT.

For reserved stalls, we ask that simple signs with the number of tie spots be used -- no wire, tape, etc.

THIS IS A HAZARD TO THE CLEANING CREWS AND PREVIOUSLY RESULTED IN A NEAR SERIOUS INJURY.

Hog pens may not be reserved early, pens will be selected upon arrival.

Bedding may not be placed until Tuesday, July 25th.

Livestock may not arrive on the grounds until Wednesday, July 26th at 2pm CST.

BE COURTEOUS ABOUT STALL SPACE AS WE ARE ANTICIPATING LARGE NUMBERS.

Cattle Exhibitors: please make sure tack is on the outside of the stalls.

DO NOT LEAVE TIE SPACES OR EMPTY PENS BETWEEN FAMILIES.

Sheep / Goat Exhibitors: your animals will be penned 2 head/pen and 1 tack pen/family.

SHOW COORDINATORS HAVE THE RIGHT TO ASK YOU TO MOVE IF YOU ARE IN VIOLATION.

BEDDING WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE AT THE 4-H FEED SHED

No straw allowed for any species except breeding sheep, only wood chips / shavings.

HEALTH PAPERS ARE REQUIRED AND WILL BE COLLECTED

BREEDING DOE CLASSES

COMMERCIAL DOE

A doe that is more production oriented, these does are not required to be registered, but will be judged on a standard similar to the registered does.

REGISTERED DOE

A doe that has a paper registered in the child's name and/or family name and has been tattooed. All purebred and percentage does will show together in one show. Registration papers must be shown at check-in, and tattoos will be checked.

AGE DIVISIONS

JR DOE - 3 to under 6 months [born 3.1.2023 - 5.31.2023]

JR DOE - 6 to under 9 months [born 12.1.2022 - 2.28.2023]

JR DOE - 9 to under 12 months [born 9.1.2022 - 11.30.2022]

YEARLING DOE - 12 to under 16 months [born 5.1.2022 - 8.31.2022]

YEARLING DOE - 16 to under 20 months [born 1.1.2022 - 4.30.2022]

SR DOE - 20 to under 24 months [born 9.1.2021 - 12.31.2021]

SR DOE - 24 to under 36 months [born 9.1.2020 - 8.31.2021]

SR DOE - 36 months or over [born prior to 8.31.2020]

BREEDING DOES WILL BE SHOWN BY AGE, YOUNGEST TO OLDEST.

ALL DOES MAY BE TRIMMED AND FIT TO ENHANCE THEIR INDIVIDUAL QUALITIES.
BRACING IS NOT ALLOWED FOR BREEDING DOES.

MARKET GOAT CLASSES

MARKET WETHER

A wether goat that is fed for market purpose. Must be slick shorn 3/8" hair or less. Hair may be left on legs up to hocks and knees only.

MARKET DOE

A doe that is fed for market purpose. Must be slick shorn 3/8" hair or less. Hair may be left on legs up to hocks and knees only.

WETHER DOE

A doe that has the wether style breeding, these does will be the type of doe that would raise a market style goat. These does shall not have kidded and must be under two years of age. They may be trimmed and fit to enhance their individual qualities.

ALL MARKET GOATS + WETHER DOES WILL BE BROKEN INTO CLASSES BY WEIGHT. CLASSES WILL BE BROKEN BY THE DISCRETION OF THE SHOW COORDINATORS. BRACING IS ALLOWED FOR MARKET GOATS.

BREEDING DOE SHOW FORMAT

COMMERCIAL DOE SHOW

Will show by age, classes broken by age. Goats shown youngest to oldest.

REGISTERED DOE SHOW

Will show by age, classes broken by age. Goats shown youngest to oldest.

The judge will pick a Top 5 in both the Registered + Commercial Does.

All first + second place class winners will be brought back for Champion + Res. Commercial and Registered Doe.

A third, fourth + fifth Overall Commercial and Registered Doe will be picked by the judge.

MARKET GOAT SHOW FORMAT

WETHER DOE SHOW

Will show by weight, classes broken by weight. Goats shown lightest to heaviest

All first + second place class winners will be brought back for Champion + Res. Wether Doe.

A third, fourth + fifth Overall Wether Doe will be picked by the judge.

MARKET GOAT SHOW

Classes split into does + wethers. Will show by weight, classes broken by weight. Goats shown lightest to heaviest.

All first + second places does will return for the Top 5 Market Doe.

All first + second places wethers will return for the Top 5 Market Wether.

Top 5 Does + Top 5 Wethers will return for Champion+ Reserve Overall Market Goat.

A third, fourth + fifth Overall Market Goat will be picked by the judge.

SHOWMANSHIP

BREEDING DOE + MARKET GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

The Spotlight Goat Show will offer two showmanship classes, one following the Breeding Doe Show and one following the Market Goat Show. If an exhibitor is a member of the SD Jr. Point Show Association and shows in both shows, the show they receive the most points in will be the one recorded for Summer Spotlight. They will not receive points from both showmanship contests.

PeeWee showmen may only be assisted by another showperson showing in the goat show.

SHOWMANSHIP FOLLOWING THE BREEDING DOE SHOW WILL FOLLOW ALONG THE STANDARD BREEDING GOAT RULES.

NO BRACING OF DOES, DEFINITION OF BRACING IS WHEN THE SHOWMAN STANDS IN FRONT OF THE DOE AND HOLDS HEAD IN A MANNER AS ASSOCIATED WITH THE STYLE OF SHOWING A MARKET GOAT AND GOAT IS PUSHING FORWARD AGAINST SHOW PERSON. NO EXCESSIVE SLAPPING OF GOATS.

SHOWMANSHIP FOLLOWING THE MARKET GOAT SHOW WILL FOLLOW ALONG THE STANDARD MARKET GOAT RULES.

ALLOW SHOW PERSON TO BRACE, BUT NO SUSPENDING GOAT'S FEET FROM THE GROUND OTHER THAN GETTING GOAT IN PLACE. ONCE IN PLACE, THE GOAT'S FEET SHOULD TOUCH THE GROUND.

NO EXCESSIVE SLAPPING OF GOATS.

ELIGIBLE HEIFER AGES: BORN SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 + AFTER - BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2023 NO COW/CALF PAIRS

THE ANGUS FUTURITY SHOW HELD DURING THE SUMMER SPOTLIGHT SHOW IS SPONSORED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE SD ANGUS ASSOCIATION (SDAA). THE FOLLOWING RULES MUST BE MET TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SHOW:

1. All heifers must have ownership transferred to a sole SD Jr. Angus Association (SDJAA) member who is showing the heifer show day. A SDAA board member must approve any substitutions if the junior listed in unable to show.

2. Only one heifer entry per junior exhibitor.

3. Altering the conformation and appearance of an animal is prohibited. Otherprohibited products include steroids, illegal pharmaceutical or artificial filling. Anyanimal found to be in violation will be barred from showing.

4. In being associated with a jackpot show, the use of black paint and other aerosols are accepted.

5. All decisions made by the SDAA Board of Directors are final.
